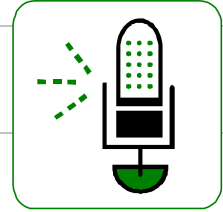

Like I mentioned at our year-end event, I want to make education a priority. The survey questions returned to us so far have a commonality in that everyone would like to have

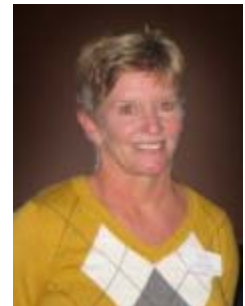
more educational opportunities. From etiquette, to pace of play to short games, we're planning opportunities for you expand and improve your games.
